Town of Spring Lake is actively prepared for the upcoming winter storm, such as Public Works, the Streets Department, and Emergency Services personnel monitoring conditions and ready to respond as needed to ensure public safety and continuity of essential services.

At this time, Town of Spring Lake offices will be open on Monday, February 2, 2026, with a two-hour delay, opening at 10:00 am.

Additional updates regarding Monday's operations, if necessary, will be communicated Sunday evening through official Town of Spring Lake communication channels.

Residents are encouraged to continue monitoring Town announcements and to exercise caution during inclement weather conditions.

Prepare Now and Plan to Stay Home and Off the Roads This Weekend

Town of Spring Lake urges all residents to complete preparations by Friday evening ahead of the anticipated winter storm expected to impact our area this weekend.

- **Be Informed**
 - Monitor trusted sources such as local media, the National Weather Service, and official Town of Spring Lake communications.
 - Visit www.ReadyNC.gov for winter storm preparedness tips, resources, and emergency planning guidance.
- **Have a Plan**
 - How will you safely heat your home if power is lost?
 - Where will you go if you are unable to remain at home?
 - How will you cook safely during a power outage?
 - Use caution when operating generators, fireplaces, or space heaters.
- **Prepare Your Disaster Kit** – Have supplies ready to last 3–5 days, including:

- One gallon of water per person per day
- Non-perishable food for all household members
- Pet food and supplies
- Flashlights and extra batteries
- Cell phone charging supplies and/or a weather radio
- Warm clothing and blankets
- First aid kit and fire extinguisher
- **Stay Home and Off the Roads**
 - Residents are strongly encouraged to stay home and avoid travel beginning Saturday morning and continuing through at least Monday, unless absolutely necessary.
 - Emergency responders and NCDOT crews must be given priority on roadways.
 - Stranded vehicles may be marked with yellow caution tape, indicating they have been checked and are not an emergency.
 - Please call 911 only for emergencies.
